CONSTRUCTION SITES



- · Sites to reopen when cases are less than 1,000 (Taoiseach 31/1/21)
- Level 5 to continue to 5th March 2021
- Same exemptions
- PUP up 9% from last week

- Clients make decisions on supporting DT's in Feb
- Home-schooling very challenging



CONTRACTS



- Contract delay notices being issued
- Tender period extensions due to supply chain resource issues
- New round of negotiations commence

- increase at Rosslare Port
- Price increase Notifications on Timber. Steel and Insulation



PIPELINE



- · Active sectors moving (Resi; data centres etc)
- Retail and Hospitality slower
- Early stage pipeline has reduced but likely to rebound post-vaccine
