CONSTRUCTION SITES



- Unlikely sites will reopen even though cases <1,000
- Possible phased reopening from March 8th



 Case numbers avg. 932 for last 5 days

DESIGN TEAMS



- Phased reopening of schools from 22nd Feb
- Continuing restrictions waring...
- Work busy but more peaks and troughs

CONTRACTS

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- Contract delay notices being issued
- Tender period extensions due to supply chain resource issues
- New round of negotiations commence



BREXIT & SUPPLY CHAIN

 Customs Clearance Agents being engaged



- Freight trade with the UK was down 50% from normal levels in January
- IIFA warning to be ready for when trade volume increases

PIPELINE



- Active sectors moving (Resi; data centres etc)
- Retail and Hospitality slower
- Early stage pipeline has reduced but likely to rebound post-vaccine
