- Contractors very frustrated at partial reopening



 4<sup>th</sup> May likely for remainder of industry but dates to be confirmed towards end of April


#### **VACCINE**



- Vaccination rollout has improved. 7-day average of 18,000 pers./day
- High of 31,011 people vaccinated on 2<sup>nd</sup> April



 Current restriction is supply, not administering




#### **BREXIT & SUPPLY CHAIN**

#### **PIPELINE**



- Active sectors moving (Resi; data centres etc)
- Retail and Hospitality slower
- Early stage pipeline has reduced but likely to rebound post-vaccine




#### **STATISTICS**
